


Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) is one of the leading causes of non-traumatic mortality in the US^{2,3}




25%

25% of SCA is related to **inherited cardiac conditions (ICCs)**^{2,3}



50%

In people **under 35 years of age**, 50% of SCA is related to ICCs^{2,3}



100,000

In the US alone, **roughly 100,000 people per year die** of SCA due to ICCs—approximately the same amount of people who die from Alzheimer's disease^{2,3}



70%

Researchers can identify up to **70% of causal variants in genes related to ICCs**⁴
